Thank you for inviting me and members of the board of the Western Cuyahoga Audubon Society (WCAS) to the Fairgrounds to become familiar with the site of a proposed wind turbine.

As I said at the Middleburg Heights zoning hearing on your turbine request, WCAS applauds your green energy proposal to move away from electricity generated by the burning of fossil fuels to electricity generated from clean, renewable wind energy.
